Abbeywood recording artist and Juno Award winner Hennie Bekker releases his CD box set, the "**African Tapestries Collection**" through henniebekker.com, abbeywoodrecords.com, amazon.com and as digital downloads through **iTunes** and other major online music sites.

The collection consists of five awe-inspiring albums from the "African Tapestries" series - "**Temba**" (Hope), is the first of the collection, with over 100,000 copies sold world-wide. The music has you stomping your feet to a groovy Soweto rhythm, through an orchestral journey over the Okavango Delta. "**The Smoke That Thunders**" brings a more personal experience of **Bekker's** time growing up near Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe. The album showcases an eclectic mix of instrumental and world music, displaying his talent as a multi-genre artist. "**Kusasa**" (Tomorrow), pays tribute to his homeland and "**Jabula**" offers the feeling and essence of 'jabula', which means "to be happy" in Zulu. The newest addition to the series, "**Amani**" (Peace) is a masterpiece of ambient and world music. It echoes Bekker's vivid reminiscences of listening to the sounds of nature and the wilderness from the top of the Vumba Mountains.

The "African Tapestries Collection" is an expedition of world music interwoven with the sounds and rhythms from Bekker's roots. His unique ability to connect memories with his music allows the listener to experience Africa in a whole new way.

Hennie Bekker is a master composer, award-winning, multi-platinum and internationally selling musician.
